Associate Ministers/Evangelists

What We Do: Generally speaking, an associate/assistant pastor is a pastor who serves in a supporting role to a church's senior pastor. Sometimes the role is somewhat of an internship, preparing the man to later serve as a senior pastor. Other times an associate/assistant pastor performs administrative responsibilities to free up the senior pastor to focus more on teaching, preaching, and discipleship.

Deacons

What We Do: In a modern church, deacons' responsibilities may include taking on administrative or organizational tasks, ushering, being responsible for building maintenance, or volunteering to be the church treasurer. It depends on the need and the gifts of the available men. Deacons are to be blameless, the husband of one wife, a good household manager, respectable, honest, not addicted to alcohol and not greedy (1 Timothy 3:8-12). According to the Word, the office of deacon is an honor and a blessing. "For those who serve well as deacons gain a good standing for themselves and also great confidence in the faith that is in Christ Jesus" (1 Timothy 3:13).

Deaconesses

What We Do: The various duties of a deaconess would pattern those of a deacon: visiting the ill, helping the poor, and serving in other ways, basically on behalf of women in need. A major Scripture passage that becomes a focal point on the subject is Romans 16:1 and 2, where Paul said to the Roman believers, "I commend to you Phoebe our sister; who is a servant of the church in Cenchrea, that you may receive her in the Lord."

Wreaths for Water Ministry

What We Do: The “Wreaths for Water” Ministry is a ministry of healing for the world, for the brokenness of men, women and children who have to drink water that causes water-borne illnesses that lead to death.

Youth & Young Adult Ministry (YYAM)

What We Do: The goal of our Youth and Young Adult Ministry is to encourage young people to have a lifelong relationship to God and a commitment to building His kingdom; and equip them with the resources needed for a living and well-developed faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

Trustees

What We Do: The role of trustee varies depending on denomination and congregation. Trustees may be responsible for maintaining buildings and facilities, tracking the church's equipment and investments, keeping insurance policies up to date, and managing funds. In a large church, a trustee may oversee several different ministries, including a finance department and janitorial staff. In others, the trustee is the janitor. Trustees can be appointed or elected, are occasionally elders or deacons, and may have the authority to serve as signatories for the church.

Ushers

What We Do: A church usher is a person who helps ensure a smoothly running church service and who ministers to people in a variety of practical ways. The specific responsibilities of an usher vary with the church, but his duties usually include greeting people as they arrive for the service, assisting people with special needs, and collecting the offering. Some churches provide a pin or name tag of some kind to easily identify their ushers.

Missionaries

What We Do: The women in our Missionary Ministry are called to grow in knowledge and experience of God through Jesus Christ, committed to support the mission of the church, and empowered by the Holy Spirit. They are challenged to help one another engage in ministry and action, and grow and respond in faith to God's redemptive plan for the church, the community, and the world.
